Christian Education Winter/Spring Registration 2019 Course Descriptions

Five-Star "Baseline" Training

Training intended for new members or members that may have missed training. The goal for training is to learn and commit to use five-star church principles. The course contains 2 parts, Part 1 will explore five-star principles, membership buy in and customer service techniques. Part 2 will explore evaluations and measurements and implementing a problem solving model.

Five-Star "Planning for Excellence" Training

Training designed for entire ministries to come in for a ministry effectiveness assessment and goal planning session. In this course ministries will learn to plan for effectiveness utilizing five-star techniques including aligning goals to mission, developing feedback tools, implementing a process of continue improvement and accountability. Ministry leader must sign up ministry and encourage all members to participate.

Five-Star Workshop: Finding Balance

This workshop is intended for individuals who are struggling with balancing work, life, and ministry commitments. The purpose is to assist members in living faithfully, with integrity in a fast-paced existence when life's patterns are changing around them. Our goal is to provide tools and spiritual disciplines that will support greater balance and reduced stress in family, ministry, community, and society.

Five-Star Workshop: Quality Assurance Training

This workshop is intended for Ministry Leadership. The Quality Assurance Team (QAT) is responsible for ensuring that five-star principles and programs are implemented and consistently applied within the ministry. During this workshop, leaders will explore roles and responsibilities of QAT and leaders, the process for gathering feedback, and evaluating and reporting. Additionally, they will be introduced to tools and resources available to assist ministry leaders with evaluations and observations to ensure that five-star quality is achieved.

Being Faithful in a Dry Season

A few years ago God gave me the assignment of how to be faithful in a dry season and I was truly faithful. Unfortunately, I became complacent...so there's no coincidence that I am sharing this class again. Now God is using me to help prepare others for their dry seasons. Budgeting/Money Management

If you need help getting your finances in order this is the class for you! We will deal with creating a budget that is realistic, managing the money you have and not what you don't have and how you can't afford not to tithe.

Children's & Youth Discipleship

We will utilize the FaithWeaver Now Program from the HandsOnBible Curriculum. FaithWeaver Now is a quarterly, age-graded curriculum that will be used for our young disciples ages 5 - 17. Students will learn foundational Biblical truths and discover the principles for victorious living. The three-year scope & sequence covers the Bible, from Genesis to Revelation. The Children and Youth Discipleship family will be learning the same Bible content/scripture lesson during Bishop Debnam's Bible Study hour in their age appropriate setting and instructional level.

Diabetes

Diabetes self-management education and support (DSMES) is a critical element of care for all people with diabetes. DSMES is the ongoing process of facilitating the knowledge, skills and ability necessary for diabetes self-care, as well as activities that assist a person in implementing and sustaining the behaviors needed to manage his or her condition on an ongoing basis, beyond or outside of formal self-management training.
