I woke up singing those lyrics one morning. They were written by Dawn McDaniels, one of the ministers at my church, over thirty years ago. The song, simply entitled “Trust God,” was actually recorded as a part of a live choir cassette recording, “Sunshine on a Cloudy Day.” I don’t have time to explain to young people what a cassette was, so let’s keep moving. This simple, timeless message, “Trust God,” may be exactly what you need to hear today.

How many times have you heard today’s scripture? And, if the verse is new to you how encouraging is it as you navigate life’s twists and turns. Whatever your challenge, your uncertainty, your questions - put your trust in God with all your heart. You may find yourself, like so many of us, trying to figure life out, to make everything make sense. But the challenge from the writer is to “lean not to your own understanding.” Translation - you won’t be able to figure everything out so lean not on YOU, but lean on God. This isn’t a passive approach to life. It’s actually a proactive stance - suggesting an active reliance and confidence in God’s ability to sustain, strengthen, and shape your destiny.
