LEGACY MATTERS...

...we have all heard that statement before, and at Morning Star we model this philosophy. We are inviting our members and friends to participate in a Pew & Brick Legacy Campaign. This Campaign will provide the opportunity to add your name to our physical building infrastructure, sending a message of faithfulness to generations to come.

When we moved to Woodlawn we initiated a Brick Campaign, which added over four hundred personalized bricks to our Church's Courtyard. The area is a place of legacy, tranquility, and remembrance as current members, those who have passed on, businesses and other organizations are represented in a tangible way at this central Campus location. This NEW Campaign will add additional bricks to this area and be expanded to add names to the pews in our sanctuary.

Regarding the pews, families or individuals can donate a specific amount to purchase a pew. Businesses and organizations can also consider purchasing a pew. Your legacy of faithfulness will be acknowledged with the addition of a placard to the pew. This placard could include the family name, or the name of a family member or friend who has passed on. This will be a visual indicator of the pride and personal relationship individuals and families experience as they celebrate their connection to the Ministry's legacy. The diagram included in this brochure further details the pricing amount for the pews. Brick pricing, and specific requirements, are also detailed. Why are we doing this Campaign?

As we shared, legacy matters. Many persons appreciate the opportunity to add their name, their families name, business, or organization as a public display of their commitment and support. Additionally, monies raised through this Campaign will be targeted toward dissolving the mortgage on the main Church building, a Ministry goal which will take our collective support and determination.

When do I have to decide on my purchase?

We will install bricks during the summer months. For a planned installation in July, your brick would have to be ordered (and paid for) by Sunday, May 28th. Regarding pews, orders (and the placement of placards) will happen throughout the year. In order to have your pew identified in 2023, an order would have to be completed (including payment) by October 31st.

Can I handle my payments in installments?

Installment payments can be established when placing your order. A 25% deposit is due at time of order. Payments must be completed in full before items are ordered. Specific to the pews, all orders (for 2023), must be paid in full by October 31st. There is a \$50 cancellation fee associated with any order.

Can I purchase multiple pews?

You are allowed to purchase as many pews as you would like and have the placards, in line with the listed requirements, designed appropriately. And of course, you are welcome to purchase multiple bricks. We should also mention, as you should have observed, you pick your specific pew based upon pricing and availability.

Are there specific requirements for what can be written on a brick and the pew placard?

Yes. Refer to this brochure and the website for additional specific requirements regarding wording, fonts, etc.

Can ministry groups purchase bricks and pews?

Indeed. Ministries, discipleship classes, and as we shared, individuals, families, businesses, and organizations, are welcome to purchase pews and bricks.


Once purchased, do individuals and families have the right to reserve that pew for their seating?


